Baked Goods Competition and Rules:

Individuals or groups may submit an entry. **Theme: "Celebrating 100 Years, Powhatan County Fair."** All entries must be made of edible ingredients. Entries must be put in clear zipper lock plastic bags, using disposable plate. Fair holds no responsibility for damaged or misplaced items.

Division 1 Youth:

Ages 5-8

Division 2 Youth:

Ages 9-13

Division 3 Youth:

Ages 14-18

Division 4 Parent/Child, Grandparent/Grandchild, or Guardian/Child: Ages 5-18

Division 5 Adult: Ages 19 and older

Rules

Must submit half-dozen cookies (6)

1. Cookies created from scratch or boxed mix are allowed.
2. All cookies must be prepared by the child; adult assistance allowed only in category 4.
3. Decorated cookies will be judged on appearance (50%), originality (30%), adhere to theme (20%).
4. Cookies may be presented in decorated boxes, trays, plates, etc.

No baked goods will be returned. Ribbons will be available for pick up after the contest.

Contest Guidelines:

1. Entries will be received from 3 to 5PM on Friday, May 17, in the main building at the Powhatan Fairgrounds, 4042 Anderson Highway.
2. Judging will begin at 6:00 PM.
3. Ribbons will be awarded then cookies left on display throughout the weekend.
4. Contestants will be admitted into the Fair with prepared entry on the day of the contest through the main gate. *If contestants plan to stay for judging, individuals will need to pay the fair entry fee; if just dropping off, no fee.
5. Entries may be brought in any type of disposable container; it is not the responsibility of the Fair to return any dishes or containers.
6. Entries must be prepared at home and brought to the fair on the day and time of the contest.
